Devotion: This story is so amazing. This poor widow had nothing to offer but a little oil. In the hands of God though, it was enough. God has given them to you for a reason. Trust God to multiply what you have committed to Him - because He will.

Prayer: Lord, thank you for always multiplying the little that I have, and for the gifts that you have placed inside of me. I know you will increase what I give you above and beyond more than I can ask or think. I always want to use my gifts to honor you. Devotion: How do we react to disappointments? How do we react when we don't get our own way? It takes on a whole new meaning when we choose to respond in a more loving way. To have a right attitude, we need to stop feeling sorry for ourselves when we don't get our own way. This is a hard lesson to learn, because it does hurt and makes us angry. But we do need to try to choose to react lovingly. Taking on a wrong attitude, for whatever reason, causes us to become angry on the inside. This is a sad and lonely place to be. God loves you and wants you to be free from the hurts and anger that results in having a 'bad attitude'. There are going to be disappointments and frustrations in life. People do let us down, but we have to seek God through it all and allow His love into the situation. Ask Him for the help you need in how you will respond to it all.

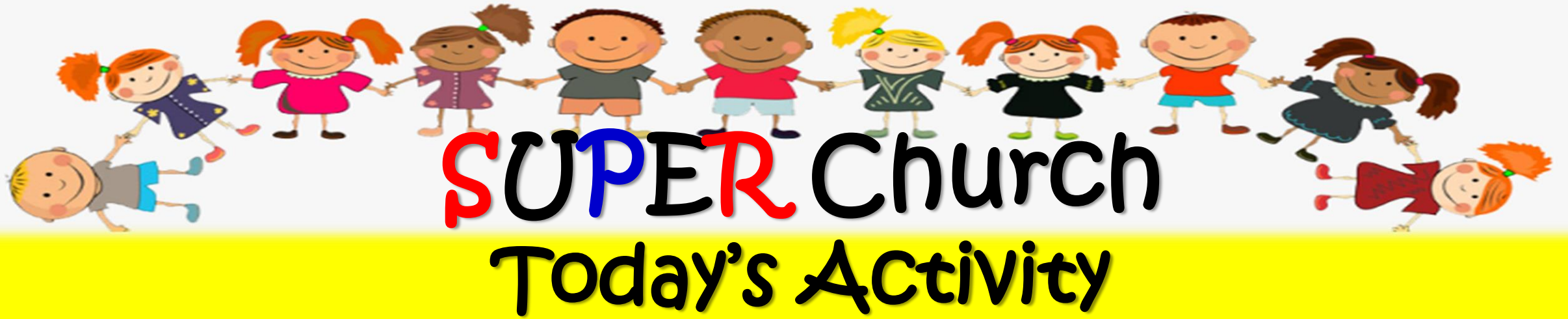
