Devotion: This parable is an illustration of God's mercy and forgiveness towards us. The king had mercy on his servant and wiped his debt—the money that he owed, because the servant begged him to be patient with him and have mercy on him. This servant had a huge debt that he couldn't possibly pay back, but the king had compassion on him and wiped it clean. However, when the servant went on his way, he saw a man who owed him a little bit of money, and ordered that he be thrown in prison. Shouldn't this servant who had been forgiven much, show the same mercy towards this man that owed him money? He was, just moments before, shown incredible mercy by the king, yet he couldn't show the same mercy to another man. God has shown us all the greatest mercy ever known. He has wiped our debt clean when Jesus died on the cross—though we didn't deserve it. So, when we come to Him and ask for forgiveness, He grants it to us—but He expects us to show the same mercy and forgiveness to others as well.

Devotion: Maybe you can think of a time when you have felt jealous of someone else. 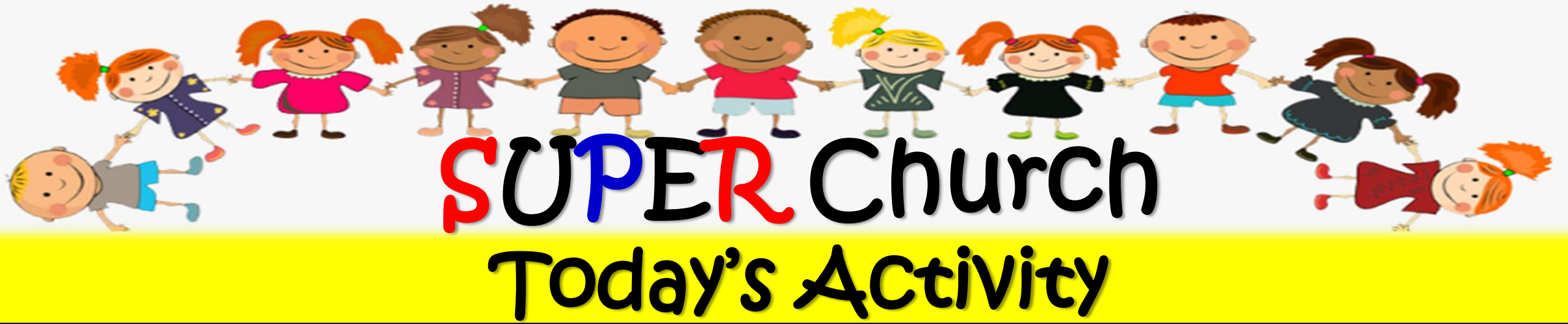

Devotion: When you enter a race, you lay aside everything that will slow you down, and your focus is on the finishing line. You run to win! Nobody runs in the hope of coming in last. If we're serious runners, we will put in the training and be focused on running well. It's much like that in the Christian life. We run to win the heavenly prize, which is waiting for us. We run with our eyes focused on Jesus and we don't get distracted with other things that are less important. We turn away from sin and everything that can cause up to make bad choices. We run with endurance and persistence—which means, we don't give up! Jesus' focus was on the cross, He never wavered from that. He knew why He came and what He had to endure. He stayed on course and won the victory over death and sin. Because of this, we can have forgiveness for our sins, we can have eternal life and we can live a victorious and full life (John 10:10). There are times, though, when we become tired and lose heart as we run our race. But even though at times it becomes hard and we feel like we can't run anymore, Jesus comes alongside us and helps us. Just remember, to keep your eyes focused on Jesus.
